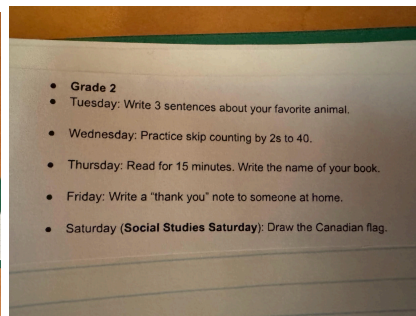
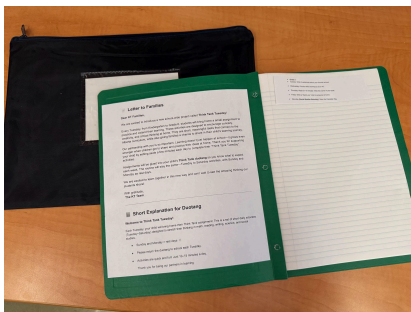
- **Christmas Concert-** Save the date:

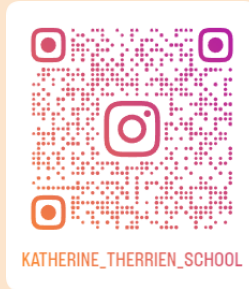

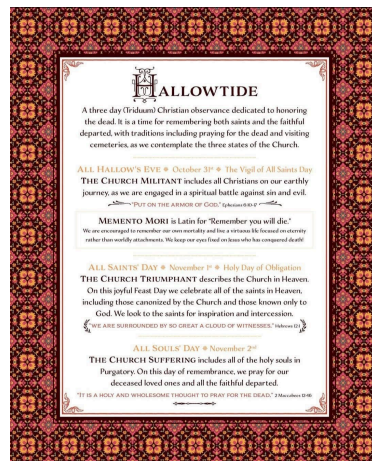
